



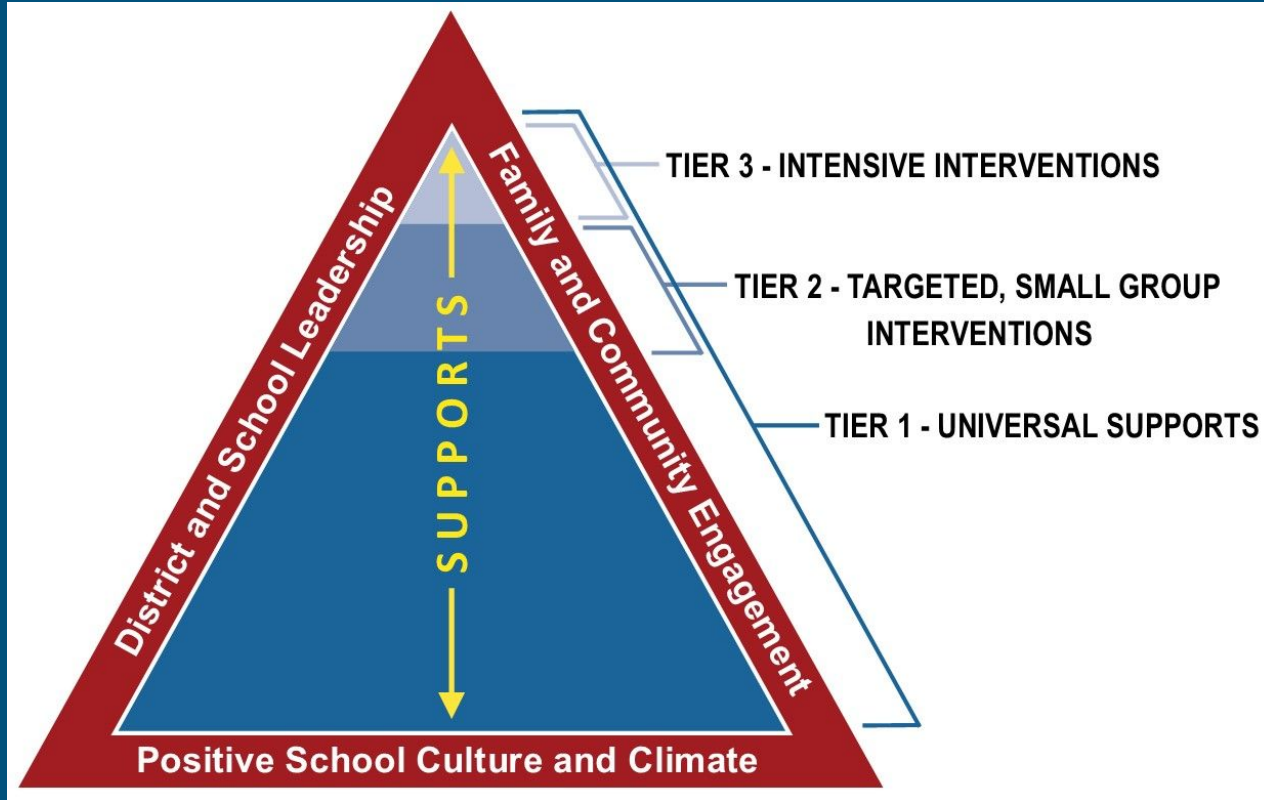
RtI and Summer Credit Recovery



What is Response to Intervention (RTI)?

- NJ Tiered System of Support: academic support and intervention
 - Tier I: Whole class instruction
 - Tier II: Supplemental supports and interventions during small group instruction in the general classroom
 - **Tier III:** Pull-out Response to Intervention (RTI) support in literacy instruction utilizing Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) program

RTI is a Tiered System of Support



Goals Looking Forward

- Continued consistency in scheduling of Tier 3 intervention
- Strengthen Tier 2 small group instruction
- Professional Development in using data to direct instruction
- Addressing middle school and mathematics intervention

Summer Credit Recovery Program

- ★ Aligned with District Policy for promotion of students
- ★ Students who fail one or more class for the year
 - Receive “Incomplete” for the class(es)
 - Complete one week of assigned work for each class that was failed
- ★ A teacher will be assigned to the program
 - Use Google Classroom to post daily assignments
 - Monitor student progress and be available for assistance as needed
 - Assess student work
- ★ If a student fails to adequately complete the credit recovery they will not be promoted to the next grade
