Climate and Culture Initiatives – The Green Township School District is committed to creating a positive, safe, and supportive environment for every student. To that end, our school district will be engaging in a multi-session series to support equity-related topic discussions. Our first session will address Dignity, Engagement, and Individualization as a positive mechanism for change. This session will be held on Tuesday, 2/20/23 from 6:30 pm – 7:30 pm in the library. NJDOE High Impact Tutoring Grant Awarded – We are pleased to announce that our school district applied for and was awarded \$38,000 in high impact tutoring grant funding via the New Jersey Department of Education. This grant funding will allow for our school to provide free, high impact tutoring to identified students who are below grade level as evidenced by NJSLA



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scores and other in house assessment metrics. Due to the grant, group size must remain at 8 or fewer students per teacher. Student tutoring sessions will run on Tuesday and Thursday afternoon until 4:30 pm. Please reach out to Mr. Bollette with any questions regarding this program.
