Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Green Township School District is committed to creating a safe and supportive learning environment for all students and staff. As part of this commitment to safety, the district has been working to upgrade a variety of systems and practices to enhance the overall safety. While we cannot provide great detail about our safety protocols, we felt that it was important to communicate a few recent upgrades.

Panic Button Installation – The school district has installed panic buttons in various places around the school. When activated, these security devices will allow for an immediate, automated call to announce the need for a lockdown and communicate instantly to law enforcement. Mr. Bollette and I spent time meeting with all of our students today to explain the new security devices in the hallways. Much like our fire alarm pull stations around the building, the students were informed that these new security devices must only be utilized in a time of emergency. The students were able to ask questions about these devices and were assured that our school is a very safe place. The addition of these devices makes our building a safer place for everyone.

Bus Identification In Bus Windows – All district buses now have an identifying label on both the driver and passenger side of the bus windows that states Green Township and the bus number. This identification is important in ensuring your child is boarding the correct bus.

Staff Lanyards – All staff have been provided with an identification lanyard to be worn throughout the school day.

Drop Off Table – The drop off table is in the main vestibule. If you are bringing in something for your child, please label it with the provided sticky notes, and we will ensure that your child gets their items.

Each of these measures provides additional security to our students and staff. We are continuing to evaluate our security measures and will provide additional updates as we implement security enhancements. Please reach out to us with any questions or concerns.
